Helps assess need and interest for community programs and events. Partners with other community agencies to bring information, resources, and services to the parish population.

COUNSELING PROGRAM

1 FULL TIME LSW • BRIDGETTE PEREZ

Caseload of about 25 clients. Total of 200 counseling cases (individuals, couples, families) since start of the program in November 2014. Promotes programming and supervises Student Intern, Case Manager, and Programming Assistant.

SOCIAL WORK INTERN • BRANDY ALEXANDER

Assists with an additional caseload of up to 10 clients, co-facilitates groups. Studies within Rutgers Social Work VAWC (Violence Against Women & Children) Program.
