



PASTOR'S MESSAGE

Dear Parishioners and Friends of Holy Family Parish,

At Mass this weekend, you probably noticed that the color of the priests' vestments have returned to green. The liturgical color of green reminds us that we are back to the Ordinary Time in the church calendar.

The word "ordinary" has a rich meaning, far beyond the usual understanding of humdrum, commonplace or everyday. The word has its source in a Sanskrit, or Indo-European, word, which entered into Latin as the verb *orior*, meaning to rise up, to be stirred up and to grow. The word for "east" in Latin, *oriens*, conveys the same rich meaning: It indicates the rising of the sun. Hence, Ordinary Time is, for Catholics, the opportunity to allow the Lord to stir up our faith, to allow our spirits to rise and to grow in our spiritual life.

Let us pray that we may use this time to grow and look for those opportunities to stir up our faith.

MENSAJE DEL PASTOR

Estimados feligreses y amigos de la Parroquia de la Sagrada Familia,

En la misa de este fin de semana, probablemente haya notado que el color de las vestiduras de los sacerdotes ha vuelto al verde. El color litúrgico verde nos recuerda que estamos de regreso al Tiempo Ordinario en el calendario de la iglesia.

La palabra "ordinario" tiene un significado rico, mucho más allá de la comprensión habitual de monotonía, lugar común o cotidiano. La palabra tiene su origen en una palabra sánscrita, o indoeuropea, que entró en latín como el verbo *orior*, que significa levantarse, ser agitado y crecer. La palabra para "este" en latín, *oriens*, transmite el mismo significado rico: indica la salida del sol. Por lo tanto, el Tiempo Ordinario es, para los católicos, la oportunidad de dejar que el Señor origine nuestra fe, de permitir que nuestro espíritu se eleve y crezca en nuestra vida espiritual.

Oremos para que podamos usar este tiempo para crecer y buscar esas oportunidades para fortalecer nuestra fe.



*A Sunday Reflection*

“And he sent messengers on ahead, who went into a Samaritan village to get things ready for him; but the people there did not welcome him, because he was heading for Jerusalem. When the disciples James and John saw this, they asked, ‘Lord, do you want us to call fire down from heaven to destroy them?’ But Jesus turned to them and rebuked them; [\*and said, ‘You do not know what sort of spirit with which you speak. For the Son of Man did not come to destroy men’s lives, but to save them.’]”

Lk 9:52-55 \*my interpretation

But the Apostles' response is typical of how we might answer and how we might treat others when we feel self-righteous and contempt for those that are not 'in the know'. We feel compelled to just write them off, use our power over them or exploit their helpless condition to rid ourselves of their annoyance even by force. We feel indifferent towards them when they seem so far from understanding our reality.

It is however, just the opposite of what Jesus wants of us. He wants us to add compassion where there is none and feel compassion when we are confronted by hate. It is of ourselves that we must sacrifice or give up so that others are to be saved.

“Sacrifice yourselves for sinners,” says Our Lady of the Rosary at Fatima. Is this not what Christ has done for us? If we are to imitate Him, we must use the Spirit He has left with us (that is, also of Him) to overcome our own challenges of the flesh as Saint Paul reminds us in Galatians 5:14-18, as well as those of society as a whole.

If we had faith (in God), we would not will or want to control others, but sadly faith is what we have the least. We are envious and jealous of others for their fame, fortune, knowledge and skill, and yes, even their good works of charity! But when we are called to task and asked to step up to the plate of decision and sacrifice, we quickly find reasons not to let our time slip out from our control. Elijah anoints his successor Elisha, but Elisha answers by first saying goodbye to his parents and his people with a tribute to God and the village. This is why Elijah sends him back. 1Kgs 19:20 It seems the right thing to do, but God wants us to drop everything to serve each other and through them serve Him. “Let the dead bury the dead!” Jesus exclaims to the disciple that first asks to bury his parent. What are we to do? Can we change our ways that profoundly to accept His will? Do we have true faith to allow the Spirit to bring us to the Father through His son, Jesus Christ? That is the true Christian disciple.

Of course, Saint Paul also concludes in Galatians that, if mankind were able to live by ‘The Great Commandment’, there would be no need for the Mosaic Law or laws in general. But we know that there is much work to be done for that to be the case and we must first accept the responsibility to do our part in God’s plan for us: ... ‘**Thy will be done.**’


