

PASTOR'S MESSAGE

Dear Parishioners and Friends of Holy Family Parish,

Pope Francis included today's gospel reading in his Encyclical Letter *Fratelli Tutti* (On Fraternity and Social Friendship). Pope Francis reminds us that each day we have to decide whether to be Good Samaritans or indifferent bystanders. And if we extend our gaze to the history of our own lives, and that of the entire world, all of us are, or have been, like each of the characters in the parable. All of us have in ourselves something of the wounded man, something of the robber, something of the passers-by, and something of the Good Samaritan.

Which character in the parable do you relate to today? I think that we all strive to be like the Good Samaritan. Pope Francis invites us to be the Good Samaritan in our world today. Looking beyond our local level, so many are wounded in our world. Too many people and institutions take the position of the passer-by. When Jesus spoke this parable, the word neighbor was understood as those from the same geographic region or nationality. Jesus asks us to go beyond and see the suffering of our global neighbors.

Being a Good Samaritan needs courage and determination. Let us pray for one another as we strive to bring this powerful parable into action in our world today.


"Jesus le dijo, 'Ve y haz lo mismo'" Lucas 10:37

A Sunday Reflection

The Greatest Commandment:

“You shall love the Lord, your God, with all your heart, with all your being, with all your strength, and with all your mind, and your neighbor as yourself.” Lk 10:27; Mt 22:37-39; Mk 12:30-31; Gal 5:18, 6:10

Again, we are presented with the main truth of our existence that we learned as first principles of our faith: The Purpose of Man’s Existence. That principal thought is to *know, love and serve God.* *Catechism of the Catholic Church* I:1

This is God’s love for the world; that the truth about His love, wisdom and creation be manifest in Man through his Son, Jesus Christ. This is the image of God that both the Old and New Testaments teach us. There is no other greater truth than this for the universe. It is utterly simple and yet difficult in the same breath. Because it means we must love all persons as Jesus loves us, and treat all His creation including our talents and gifts as things that we don’t own.

Saint Paul alludes to this very understanding when he instructs the Colossians (Col 1:15-20) that our image of the world should be through Jesus Christ, the Son, because through the Son we are brought into the “fullness” of all creation that is God the Father and receive through Him the Ever-living Spirit. The Father and Son are one and have existed before all creation, but for our sake the Father sent the Son so that we may know Him, and that beyond any doubt, we are created in His image.

It is also implied that through Jesus Christ, the Son we are also redeemed and our souls taken up with His to where He has prepared for us a place with the Father. Jn 14:2

So, the Greatest Commandment is the universal truth, and a love for the one who gives us everlasting life that is manifested by the sacrificial love we show each other as did Jesus Christ when He gave us His Body and Blood on the cross and in the Eucharist.


