

The topic of faith is included in the Catechism of the Catholic Church. The Catechism speaks about Abraham as the “father of all who believe.” St. Paul mentions how Abraham left all that he knew and followed where God directed him to go. He left his homeland and lived the rest of his life as a resident alien in a strange land. He and his wife Sarah trusted in the Lord. We know how God continued to bless them in spite of the many challenges in their life.



*A Sunday Reflection
by István Horváth
August 7, 2022*

“Much will be required of the person entrusted with much, and still more will be demanded of the person entrusted with more.” Lk 12:48b

We most often associate Luke’s words with that of handling money and rightfully so, however the same can be said of people entrusted with offices of civil and community service. These individuals enjoy the favor and trust of the people they represent and the spotlight that comes with representing a town or city’s political appointment, an organization or institution, or a community such as a club or church. Each leader has a duty to uphold the laws or by-laws of the institution that they represent, but they also have an obligation to remain impartial in the decisions of those organizations when it comes to the constituents that make up the organization’s membership.

In the case of a Church, the pastor decides on issues that impact the whole congregation whether or not the decision favors his favorite donor or not. In the case of a community that is not a church, this decision has even more weight, because the decisions impact the monetary wellbeing of the group or institution. Then the office or appointment of a civil servant is at greatest risk of being impartial, because these institutions are based on man’s laws and are always in the business of controlling people’s rights to act in society and how to dispense of the funds that are extracted from residents of that society.

So why does this seem so unattainable when it comes to society as a whole?

The obvious answer we give is that it’s politics. But politics or no politics, a Christian society functions the same at the basic level as it does at the highest level. It is the moral obligation of the individual entrusted with the office to act in the best interest of the people they represent. The problem is the words “best interest” which to most individuals simply means what is best for me is also best for everyone else. This is the non-Christian part of today’s society as a whole and the portion that trickles down into the fabric of Christian communities, the family unit. When God is removed from the ‘picture’ as in the case of civil society, you end up with God removed from the family as well.

This is the true struggle that communities face whether secular or religious in nature, because man’s laws are scarcely based on God’s laws any more; this directly impacts our religious communities and thereby our families as well. “Still more will be demanded of the person entrusted with more” – at heaven’s gate no doubt; yet it is our just conscience to which Luke is appealing.


