January 15, 2023 - 2nd Sunday in Ordinary Time

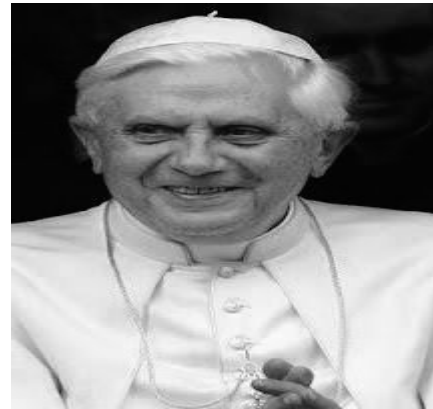
*“Now the Lord has spoken who formed me as his servant

A Sunday Reflection

Second Sunday in Ordinary Time

“God is faithful; by Him you were called into fellowship of His Son, Jesus Christ Our Lord.” 1Cor 1:9

“The Lord, the Holy One of Israel, who is faithful, has chosen you.” Is 49:7b

Saint Paul reminds the Corinthians that staying faithful to the Spirit is part of our responsibility in doing God’s will. This in the very least is obeying His Commandments (**Is 48:18**), but more so as Isaiah points out, everything we do that isn’t His will: following the vanity of our ways and the light of man-made torches instead of the ‘true light’ leads to nothingness and to our own torment. **Is 50:10-11** We must trust in the Lord in order to be comforted by Him. **Is 51:12** The reason we should be doing His will is because God has remained faithful to us despite the fact that we have not been faithful to Him. **Rom 3:3-20**

But if we look at this from a different point of view, the fact that God, the Father knows us personally from birth (**Is 49:1b,5a; Jer 1:5a; Catechism of the Catholic Church (CCC) 362., 366.**) and created us for the sole purpose of being happy with Him (**Jn 15:10-11; Ps 8:5-7; CCC 355.**), then it carries even more weight, that we be obedient to Him and sanctify His creations by forming them to His will (**Gn 1:28; CCC 358., 373.**). Indeed, to know, love and serve Him is His will, and for this we are promised an eternity of joy.

But how do we sanctify God’s creations? We can’t add a day to our lives, a strand of hair to our heads, or stop the morning of the next day from arriving. We can’t even accomplish anything of significance or importance without His help. Yes, this is true, but if we understand this truth and utterly humble ourselves to its meaning, that we are nothing and useless without God, then and only then, can we accept Him truly, trust in Him completely, rely on Him absolutely without conditions. This is true faith. “Though I thought I had toiled in vain, for nothing and for naught spent my strength, my justice is yet with the Lord, my recompense is with my God.” **Is 49:4** “The Lord opened my ear; I did not refuse, did not turn away.” **Is 50:5**; “Here I am, send me!” **Is 6:8d** “[And] [T]hen He opened their minds to understand the scriptures.” **Lk 24:45; Rom 12:2** By having true faith and trust in God, we have true inheritance in Jesus Christ, The Son. **Eph 1:18** Through this act of faith we are granted the power of His Spirit. With His Spirit we are able to sanctify the created world in works of charity on it, through Jesus Christ in us. We become creators of good and goodness through the sanctity of Jesus Christ, Our Lord. Our actions will bear fruit many times the effort we invest and our happiness will start to grow through the joy we bring to others. The take-home message is: God has a plan for us, as long as we have faith in Him.

John testified, “The One Who sent me to baptize with water told me, ‘On whomever you see the Spirit come down and remain, He is the Son of God.’” Jn 1:33
