

Fifth Sunday of Easter

Jesus said to His Disciples, “It is not for you to know the times or seasons [when judgment or events are to come and pass] that the Father has established by His own authority!” However, [it is your responsibility] when you receive the Holy Spirit and It comes upon you, that you be my witnesses [here] and to the ends of the earth. Acts 1:7-8

“If you love me, you will keep my Commandments. I will not leave you orphans; I will come to you. And I will ask the Father, and He will give you another Advocate to be with you always, the Spirit of truth ... In a little while the world will no longer see me, but you will see me, because I live and you will live [also]. On that day you will realize that I am in my Father and you are in me and I in you. Whoever knows and observes my Commandments is the one who loves me. And whoever loves me will be loved by my Father, and I will love him and reveal myself to him.” Jn 14:15-17a,18-21

“Go, therefore, and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit, teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you. And behold, *I am* always with you, to the end of the world!” Mt 28:19-20

“Stephen, filled with the Holy Spirit, looked up intently to Heaven and saw the glory of God and Jesus standing at the right hand of God, and he said, ‘Behold, I see the Heavens opened and the Son of Man standing at the right hand of God.’” Acts 7:55-56
