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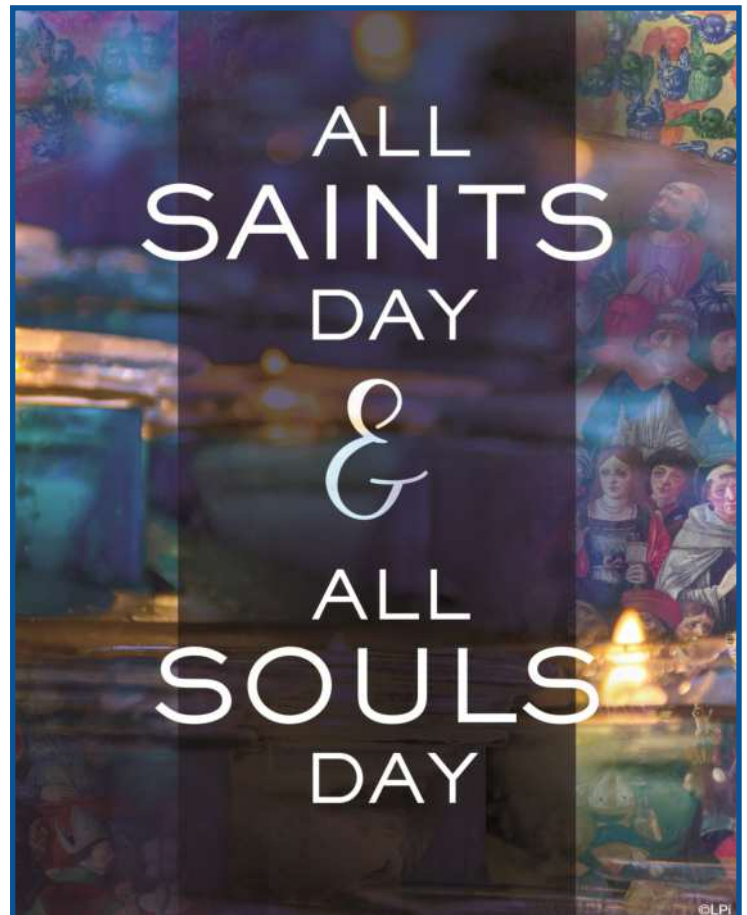

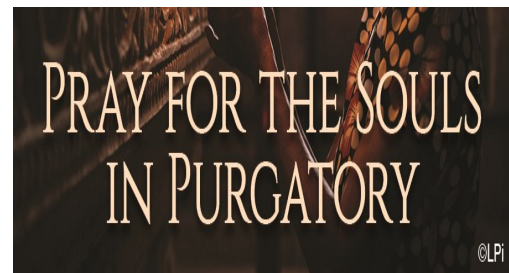

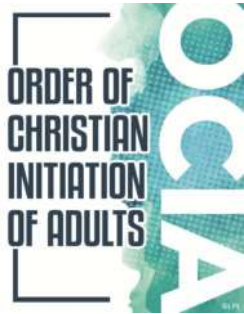

"...Porque yo vine del cielo no hago mi propia voluntad sino la del que me ha enviado..." JUAN 6:38

Cuando rece el Padrenuestro, diga las palabras lentamente de manera que pueda reconocer con certeza lo que está diciendo. Cada día cuando rezamos esta oración, repetimos lo que Jesús dijo en el pasaje de las escrituras – "venga a nosotros tu reino, así en la tierra como en el cielo". Cuando decimos estas palabras, ¿nuestras acciones reflejan lo que decimos? Esa es la diferencia entre los santos y el resto de nosotros. Los santos son fieles y obedientes de la voluntad de Dios. Empiece hoy - comience a alinear sus palabras y acciones con la voluntad de Dios.

WE ARE CALLED TO BE SAINTS

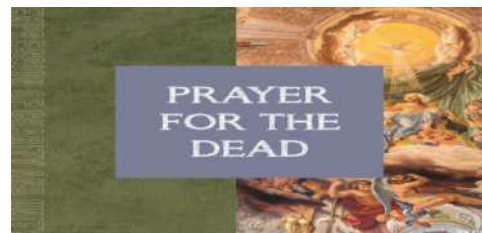
The phrase "we are called to be saints" means all Christians are called to live a holy life, set apart for God. According to the New Testament, sainthood is not an achievement but an identity received through faith in Jesus Christ, which implies a call to live a life that reflects that new identity. This is an ongoing process of growing in holiness, made possible by cooperating with God's grace.



All Souls' Day, celebrated on November 2nd, is a day of remembrance for all the faithful departed. It's a day to pray for the souls of loved ones, particularly those in purgatory, who are believed to be undergoing purification before entering heaven.

Celebrations often include attending Mass, visiting cemeteries, and lighting candles, and are based on the Catholic belief in the "communion of saints"—the connection between those on earth, in purgatory, and in heaven.

El Día de los Fieles Difuntos, que se celebra el 2 de noviembre, es un día de recuerdo para todos los fieles difuntos. Es un día para orar por las almas de los seres queridos, particularmente aquellos en el purgatorio, que se cree que están pasando por la purificación antes de entrar al cielo. Las celebraciones a menudo incluyen asistir a misa, visitar cementerios y encender velas, y se basan en la creencia católica en la "comunidad de los santos": la conexión entre los que están en la tierra, en el purgatorio y en el cielo.

A Sunday Reflection

“For the Son of Man has come to seek and to save what was lost.” Lk 19:10 Just as God, the Father has done from man’s creation “... rebuking offenders little by little, warning them, and reminding them of the sins they are committing, that they may abandon their wickedness and believe in [Him], The Lord! ... condemning them by degrees, giving them space for repentance. And giving His children reason to hope that He would allow them to repent for their sins.” Wis 12:2, 10a, 19b

Have we ever felt in a particular situation, usually when things are not going as we planned, ‘God is trying to tell me something?’ Of course we have, but the question is really, what did we do about it in reply? Did we look for other signs and seek out His will for ourselves, or did we just continue in our ways and write it off as a stroke of bad luck?

We are afraid of true faith in the Living God!
We would rather deal with the afflictions of a bad decision we make than confront our conscience to see the truth. The devil supplies the distractions so that we never see ourselves in the light of Truth, Jesus Christ. Oh, the bliss of ignorance. And God waits, and waits and ... Waits for us to come to our senses. “For You love all things that are and loathe nothing that you have made; for You would not create what You hate.” Wis 11:24

“We ought to give thanks to God for salvation through sanctification by the Spirit and belief in truth. [Because] to this end he has [also] called us through the [words of the] Gospel to possess the glory of Our Lord Jesus Christ.” 2Thes 2:13-14 Infinite love is practiced with infinite patience. So, we should also give thanks to God that He waited for us to find Him, before it was too late.

An All Souls Remembrance:

“We do not want you to be unaware, brothers [and sisters in Christ], about those who have fallen asleep, so that you may not grieve like the rest, who have no hope. For if we believe that Jesus died and rose, so too will God, through Jesus, bring with him those who have fallen asleep. Indeed, we tell you this, on the word of the Lord, that [those] who are [still] alive, who are left until the coming of the Lord, will surely not precede those who have fallen asleep. For the Lord Himself, with a word of command, with the voice of an archangel and with the trumpet of God, will come down from heaven, and the dead in Christ will rise first. Then we who are alive, who are left, will be caught up together with them in the clouds to meet the Lord in [mid-] air. Therefore, console one another with these words.”

1 Thes 4:13-18

“For we are the temple of the Living God: [As He said]: ‘I will live with them and move among them, and I will be their God and they shall be my people. ... and I will be a father to you, and you shall be sons and daughters to me, says the Lord Almighty.’”

2 Cor 6:16b-18

“For that which is corruptible must clothe itself with incorruptibility, and that which is mortal must clothe itself with immortality. And when this which is corruptible clothes itself with incorruptibility and this which is mortal clothes itself with immortality, then the word that is written shall come to pass:
