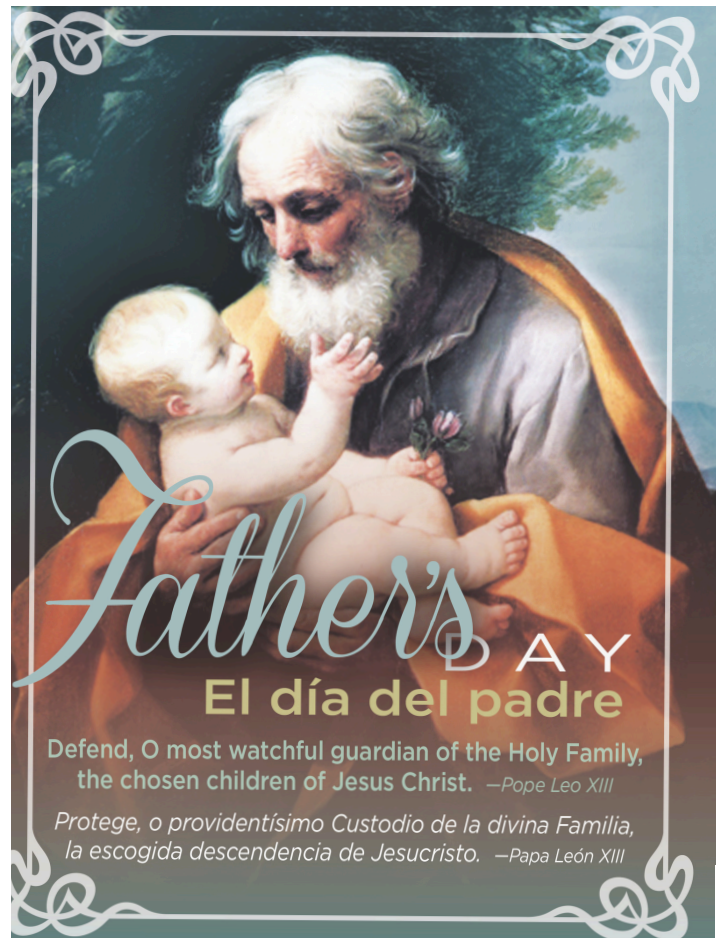

A Reflection by Istvan Horvath



Twelfth Sunday in Ordinary Time

Do not be afraid ... for those who fear are not of the living.

Of the coming persecution of Christians and in particular Catholics, Jesus says, "Beware of people, for they will hand you over to courts ... and lead you before governors and kings for my sake as a witness before them and pagans. Brother will hand over brother to death, father his child; children will rise up against parents and have them put to death. You will be hated by all, because of my name, but whoever endures to the end will be saved! Therefore do not be afraid of them. Nothing is concealed that will not come to be revealed, nor secret that will not be known. Do not be afraid of those who might kill the body, but cannot kill the soul, rather be afraid of the one who can destroy both soul and body and send it to the fires of Hell." Mt 10:17-18,21-22,26,28

When we imagine a colossal battle between good and evil we envision a scenario as the one quoted above from Jesus Himself spoken to His Disciples. Why does Jesus tell His Disciples to forgo their own safety, rather than succumb to the will of the agents of the evil one? Because, those that seek to control us always prey on our fears and conveniently use it against us: "It is for your own safety" - they say - as they take away our basic human rights to decide our future, and the right to exercise our free will to choose between good and evil. It is those who are not afraid, who inherit the Kingdom, those who remain righteous in faith and truth in the sight of the Almighty. The Truth (Jesus Christ and His teachings) will set us free! (Jn 8:32), not the mob of self-idolatry or power and control over the weak. We have built a society of isolation and fear into our lives. We live in the fear of loss of our wealth, our belongings, our status, our health, our jobs, and our livelihood. All because we don't trust and give our lives to God. Mt 6:25,32 Do we not recognize the times? Mt 24:32-33 "The wind blows where it will, ... yet we do not know from where it comes from; ... so it is with everyone born of the Spirit." Mt 3:8

Live for the Truth and love your God! And do not be afraid of stating and saying the Truth! Because, it is righteous to die for the Truth, rather than for sin that consumes your soul and body alike. Mt 10:28 Believe in Jesus Christ, trust in His redemptive power and free yourself from the chains of earthly things and power. Trust in the Sacred Heart of Jesus to open your heart to sacrificial love of one another. Mt 10:39; Lk 9:24 You won't need any of your earthly things in Heaven and you can't take it with you anyway. Otherwise, everyone would be packing a BIG fat lunchbox at their funeral. You will need your soul, however. Will your soul to God!
