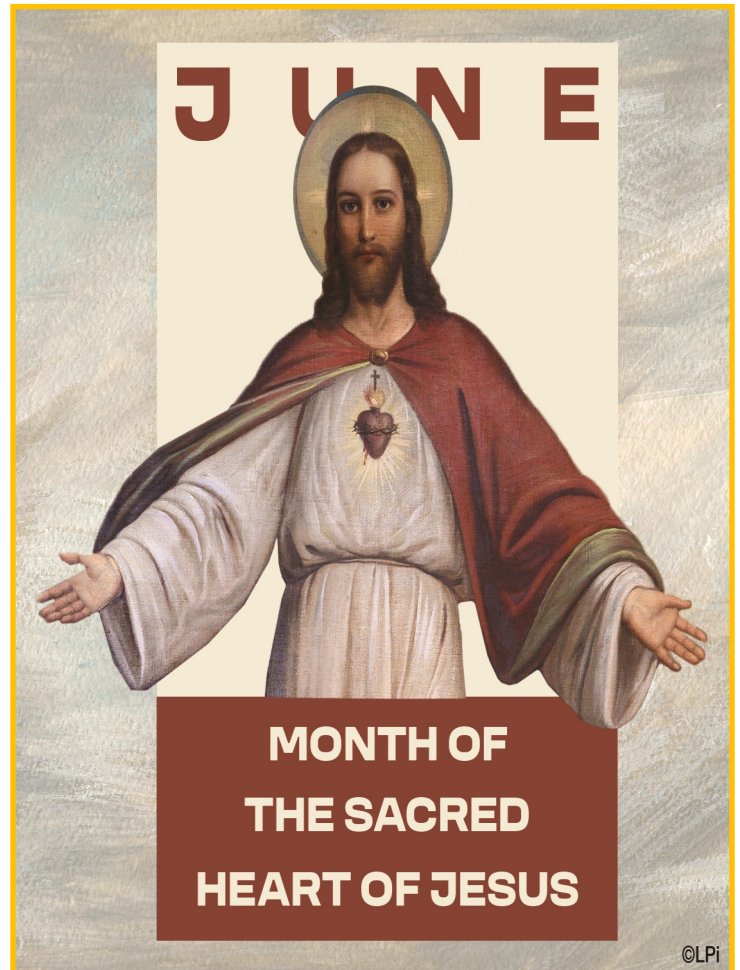

June is designated as the month of the Sacred Heart of Jesus. This devotion received a surge of popularity in the late 1600s. Jesus appeared several times to a French religious sister, St. Margaret Mary Alacoque, pointing to his heart. During this time, the Jansenist heresy had risen in France, which preached limited predestination for salvation. When appearing to Margaret Mary, Jesus affirmed his love for all mankind: *“Behold the Heart which has so loved men that it has spared nothing.”* He asked for a special feast celebrating his Sacred Heart on the Friday following the feast of Corpus Christi. Over time, June has become known as the month of Sacred Heart.

Junio ha sido designado como el mes del Sagrado Corazón de Jesús. Esta devoción experimentó un auge de popularidad a finales del siglo XVII. Jesús se apareció en varias ocasiones a una religiosa francesa, Santa Margarita María Alacoque, señalando su corazón. Durante aquella época, había surgido en Francia la herejía jansenista, la cual predicaba una predestinación limitada para la salvación. Al aparecerse a Margarita María, Jesús afirmó su amor por toda la humanidad: «He aquí el Corazón que tanto ha amado a los hombres, que nada ha escatimado». Solicitó una fiesta especial para celebrar su Sagrado Corazón el viernes siguiente a la solemnidad del Corpus Christi. Con el paso del tiempo, junio ha llegado a ser conocido como el mes del Sagrado Corazón.

Devotion to the Immaculate Heart of Mary focuses on the purity and love of Mary's heart for God, her "Yes" to the Incarnation, and her role in Jesus' redemptive mission. It highlights her total surrender to God's will and her profound interior life, experiencing both joy and sorrow while remaining faithful.

La devoción al Inmaculado Corazón de María se centra en la pureza y el amor del corazón de María por Dios, su "Sí" a la Encarnación y su papel en la misión redentora de Jesús. Destaca su entrega total a la voluntad de Dios y su profunda vida interior, experimentando tanto la alegría como la tristeza mientras permanecía fiel.



La fiesta del Corpus Christi, también conocida como **la Solemnidad del Santísimo Cuerpo y Sangre de Cristo**, es una celebración litúrgica especial en la Iglesia Católica que honra la presencia real de Jesucristo en la Eucaristía. Como católicos, creemos que durante la Misa, el pan y el vino consagrados por el sacerdote se convierten en el verdadero Cuerpo y Sangre de Cristo.



The Feast of Corpus Christi, also known as the **Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ**, is a special liturgical celebration in the Catholic Church that honors the real presence of Jesus Christ in the Eucharist. As Catholics, we believe that during the Mass, the bread and wine consecrated by the priest become the actual Body and Blood of Christ.

RAMO ESPIRITUAL DEL DÍA DEL PADRE

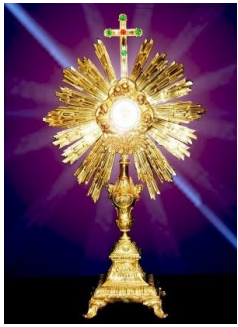

A Sunday Reflection

Corpus Christi Sunday

“Jesus said, ‘I am the living bread that came down from Heaven; whoever eats this bread will live forever; ... Amen, amen, I say to you, unless you eat the flesh of the Son of Man and drink His blood, you do not have [eternal] life within you.’” Jn 6:51, 53



Last week we heard Nicodemus instructed by Jesus on the re-birth in the Trinity through water, blood and spirit that leads to the Kingdom of God (1Jn 5:6-8); this week we hear the physical manifestation of that action, it is The Sacred Body and Blood of Jesus, Son of God in The Holy Eucharist.

By these acts we are re-born and receive God’s total love for humanity from Easter to Pentecost and our inheritance in the one true God of Hosts: the act of Baptism, the act of The Holy Eucharist and the act of Confirmation. This is the Holy Mass instituted by Jesus at the Last Supper. In going to Mass, we are truly heirs to His love and likeness through our own free will. We baptize ourselves at the Baptismal Font with Holy Water and receive the Liturgy of the Word from the ambo. We conclude our learning of His teaching with the recitation of the Credo. Then we prepare and cleanse our souls through spiritual offerings of the form of bread and wine to be transformed by Jesus to His Body and Blood. In the Consecration of the Holy Eucharist, Jesus offers up His life for ours to the Father. In a state of sanctifying grace, we partake in the Sacrificial Banquet of the Eucharist, while the Father sends down His acceptance of our offering in the act of Confirmation by His Holy Spirit. This act of Communion with the Holy Trinity is the Holy Mass, and the supernatural re-birth in faith by water, blood and spirit or In The Name of The Father, and of The Son and of The Holy Ghost. **“Amen, I say to you, unless you eat the flesh of the Son of Man and drink His blood, you do not have [eternal] life within you.” Jn 6:53**

Now that we have escaped the fate of bodily death in the natural world through our supernatural will in the Spirit, we can be with God in Paradise. It is our free will to be part of God’s love for mankind in the Holy Mass, the true presence of His Son, Jesus Christ. We should cherish this right above all earthly possessions as Children of God.

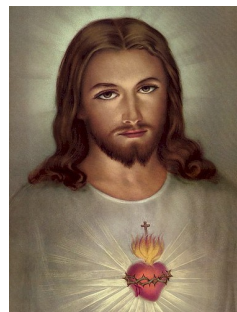
