

A Sunday Reflection

September 18, 2022

"No servant can serve two masters ... [We] can not serve both God and mammon." Lk 16:13

Mammon is the deification of wealth in our lives. Jesus warns us to be careful not to get trapped into pursuing goals that lead to self-serving interests instead of God.

We read last week that Jesus sat, ate and conversed with sinners and non-believers. This week we hear him relate the Parable of the Unscrupulous Steward, who is commended for his actions in the end. He is saying the same thing: one in actions and the other in words. Befriend your enemies and make friends among the worldly people all you believers and children of the light. Pray for those in authority, because your life and peace also depend on their wellbeing. For the worldly can become believers as well, and be saved through our actions and words, and by these actions we will have an investment in our own eternal lives. This is what God wants for all Mankind not just for His chosen ones. We should welcome conversion, but not force it upon anyone. Each individual has to choose for themselves by their own free will. But if our actions and our words help them choose God, we will be filled with God's joy for every lost soul who has been found and returned to Him, like the Parable of the Prodigal Son received back by the Father – "... your brother was dead and has come back to life again!" Lk 15:32

Indeed, if we can not be trusted with what is not ours or what belongs to God in this case (ie. our families, children or those entrusted to our care and teaching to inherit the Kingdom of God), how can we be trusted with what is ours (our own faith)? Lk 16:10-12 "Therefore, I say to you, the Kingdom of God will be taken away from you and given to a people that will produce its fruit." Mt 21:43 So is the joy of paradise according to The Lord.

Is our faith merely a mammon of our status in the world or do we live it with the conviction to attract ours to Him as well?


