

April 30th is Children's Day in Mexico. The last day of April every year marks a special occasion all across Mexico. *El Día del Niño* or Children's Day, a national celebration of children and childhood, often surprises visitors with its importance and genuine warmth. Family and children in particular are highly valued in Mexican culture, and this is reflected in the significance of the day.



May 4, 2023, is the National Day of Prayer. It is an annual day of observance held on the first Thursday of May, designated by the United States Congress, when people are asked "to turn to God in prayer and meditation". The president is required by law to sign a proclamation each year, encouraging all Americans to pray on this day.

We wish you all a good Sunday and may the spirit of Easter renewal strengthen you throughout this coming week.



Fourth Sunday of Easter


If you've lost your way, if life has closed you into a rut, if discouragement and sadness have overtaken your outlook on life, or if tragedy, suffering and sickness have left you empty and alone, don't become anxious, worried or despondent. Turn to Jesus Christ today, because Jesus loves you and wants you to seek Him out and follow Him to the light of joy and happiness. Don't let this world and its uncertainty drive and rule your life. Have faith in the One, who has brought all humanity redemption of their sins and a new heart of hope to love the One True God of life. **Jn 17:3**

As Luke recounts in the Acts of the Apostles, Saint Peter forms the first parish council to serve the needs of the expanding community, but he doesn't lose sight of his and the other Apostles' most important responsibility to spread and speak the Gospel of Jesus Christ. He realizes that naming upstanding civil members of the community and Deacons as ambassadors, best serves the needs of the community. **Acts 6:1-7** This allows Christ's vicar and his fellow bishops to do the work of the Holy Spirit and not be influenced or become infected by the views, ideas and deceptions of the civilian world. Also, frequent prayer keeps us "away from worldly desires that wage war against the soul." **1Pt 2:11b**

It is not God's will for the disciples of Christ to engage in and spend what remains of their worldly life on desires of the flesh and on the attitudes of the people in power nor their underhanded, secretive and ungodly plans for God's creations on earth. **1Pt 4:1-2** It is enough that those who make this choice that they be lost to the world and to the evil one. "For the time that has passed is sufficient [that we have squandered to such things] doing what the Gentiles like to do: living in debauchery, evil desires, drunkenness, orgies, carousing, and wanton idolatry." **1Pt 4:3** It is His will to "be serious and sober for prayers. Above all, let your love for one another be intense, because love [makes up for] a multitude of sins. Be hospitable to one another without complaining. As each one has received a gift, use it to serve one another as good stewards of God's broad-ranging grace." **1Pt 4:7b-10** Be baptized in the Spirit of life: "Whoever preaches, let it be with the words of God; whoever serves, let it be with the strength that God supplies, so that in all things God may be glorified through Jesus Christ, to whom belong glory and dominion forever and ever. Amen." **1Pt 4:11**

Jesus said to Thomas, "I am the way, the truth and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me. If you know me, then you will also know my Father. From now on you do know Him and have seen Him. Whoever has seen me has seen the Father. And whatever you ask in my *name*, I will do, so that the Father may be glorified in the Son." Jn 14:6-7,9b,13
